- Master program u oblasti javne administacije za međunarodni razvoj (MPA/RD) je interdisciplinarni program sa fokusom na ekonomiju koji je kreiran tako da obuče narednu generaciju praktičara i analitičara u oblasti međunarodnog razvoja. Mladi profesionalci iz celog sveta sa dobrim pripremama iz matematike i ekonomije se upisuju na zahtevne kurseve mikroekonomije, makroekonomije, ekonometrike, upravljanje i institucije, rukovodjenje u javnom sektoru i imaju praksu za ekonomski razvoj. Međunarodno stažiranje, nekoliko izbornih predmeta i dokument o postignuću zaokružuju program. **Rok za prijavu: 8. januar 2010**
- Edward S. Mason Program je master program iz oblasti javne uprave za one koji su odmakli u svojoj karijeri u cilju pripreme vodje za iniciranje i implementaciju glavnih političkih, društvenih ili ekonomskih promena razvojem potrebnih analitičkih, upravljačkih i rukovodstvenih veština. Kandidati moraju imati državljanstvo zemlje koja je u razvoju, na početku industrilizacije ili je u tranziciji i da imaju minimalno 7 godina iskustva kao stalno zaposlena osoba do kraja juna godine kada se podnose zahtevi. Ali za program Mason Fellows zahteva se 14 godina radnog iskustva. Kandidati obično imaju nekoliko godine iskustva na seniorskom nivou donošenja odluka. Rok za prijavu: 4. decembar 2009.


Dear Colleague:

The problems facing developing and transitional economy countries demand the attention of highly trained, committed leaders. The Harvard Kennedy School offers two graduate programs in international development:


- The **Master in Public Administration in International Development (MPA/ID)** is an economics-centered multidisciplinary program designed to train the next generation of practitioners and analysts in the field of international development. Bright young professionals from around the world with strong preparation in math and economics enroll in a demanding set of core courses in microeconomics, macroeconomics, econometrics, governance and institutions, public sector management, and the practice of economic development. An international internship, several electives and a capstone paper round out the program. **Deadline for applications: January 8, 2010.**
- The **Edward S. Mason Program** is a mid-career Master in Public Administration program designed to prepare demonstrated leaders to initiate and implement major political, social, or economic change by developing the necessary analytic, management, and leadership skills. Candidates must have citizenship from a developing, newly industrialized, or transitional economy country and a minimum of 7 years of full-time, relevant, professional experience by June of the year of admission. However, on average Mason Fellows have 14 years of work experience. Competitive candidates typically have several years of experience at a senior decision-making level. **Deadline for applications: December 4, 2009.**

We hope that you will encourage potential candidates to apply to these programs. We have enclosed a brochure for each one.
