**I. Guangxi Normal University**

Guangxi Normal University (GXNU) is located in Guilin, a world-famous tourist city with rich culture and a long history. Situated in the southern part of China, Guilin is known for having the “best landscape in the world”. In 2013, CNN selected the Li River, a famous tourist destination, as one of 15 most beautiful rivers in the world. Guilin’s karsts were listed as part of the world’s natural heritage in 2014.

Guangxi Normal University (GXNU) was founded in 1932. It is co-funded by China’s Ministry of Education and Guangxi Government. The university has 3 campuses - Wangcheng Campus, Yucai Campus and Yanshan Campus, covering a total area of 300 hectares. Wangcheng Campus has been selected as one of the most beautiful campuses in China. It is the only 5A scenic campus in the country. The diploma of GXNU is recognized by educational organizations worldwide.

**II. International Exchanges and Cooperation**

Guangxi Normal University actively carries out international exchanges and cooperation in education and is known as the “vanguard of education” in Guangxi. It has the authority to receive international students under the “Chinese Government Scholarship” awarded by China’s Ministry of Education, the “Confucius Institute

Scholarship” awarded by China’s State Office of Chinese Language Education (Han Ban), and the “ASEAN Scholarship” awarded by the Guangxi Government. It is also the only university in Guangxi approved by China’s Ministry of Education to be a demonstration base for foreigners to study in China, and to be a Chinese language education base. Each year, the university selects outstanding students and teachers to serve as overseas volunteer Chinese teachers and to carry out Chinese language teaching practices. Meanwhile, it receives teachers and students from around the world for various trainings and cultural exchange activities.
