# Who is eligible to enroll?

## The First Cycle of Studies



Everyone who has completed a four-year secondary school in the Republic of Srpska and Bosnia and Herzegovina or a corresponding secondary school abroad is entitled to enroll in the University of Banja Luka, i.e. in one of its 16 faculties and the Academy of Arts.

For those who have completed school abroad, the competent authority conducts the procedure of recognizing the public document on the level of education obtained. As to prospective students coming from Serbia, they enroll under the same conditions as candidates from the Republic of Srpska and Bosnia and Herzegovina.

## Documents required to apply and enroll

- **Birth certificate;**
- **Citizenship certificate, not older than 6 months;**
- **Original school leaving certificates and an original diploma of passing the matriculation, i.e. final exam (or a certified copy if a candidate applies for two or more study programs);**
- **Proof of payment of the fee for taking the entrance exam or an aptitude test;**
- **Medical certificate:**
  - **when applying to the University of Banja Luka, for the Faculty of Security Sciences and the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports candidates are to submit a medical certificate issued by a registered health institution; as for the Faculty of Security Sciences of the University of Banja Luka, in addition to a medical certificate, a certificate that no criminal proceedings are in progress against the candidate needs to be submitted.**
  - **when enrolling in the University of Banja Luka, candidates are to submit a medical certificate to all the faculties except the Faculty of Security Sciences and the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports.**

The candidate applies along with other necessary documentation to the Student Administration Office at the respective faculty / Academy of Arts where the study program to which the candidate is applying is conducted.

# Entry Exam

Entry exams or aptitude tests are compulsory for enrolment in the first year of the first cycle of studies.

Candidates who have achieved one of the first three places in state, RS, or regional competitions during their secondary school education in subjects relevant to the study program can be enrolled without taking the entrance exam, about which they can be informed at the respective faculty or the Academy of Arts. These candidates will be awarded the maximum number of points for the entrance exam and the aptitude test respectively.

Candidates are required to bring an identification document - a valid ID card or passport - to the entrance exam, i.e. to the aptitude test.

Candidates who are persons with disabilities can take the entrance exam in a manner adapted to their needs and in accordance with the objective possibilities of the faculty or the Academy of Arts. When applying for admission to the faculty or the Academy of Arts, these candidates must submit a written proposal on how they are going to take the entrance exam.

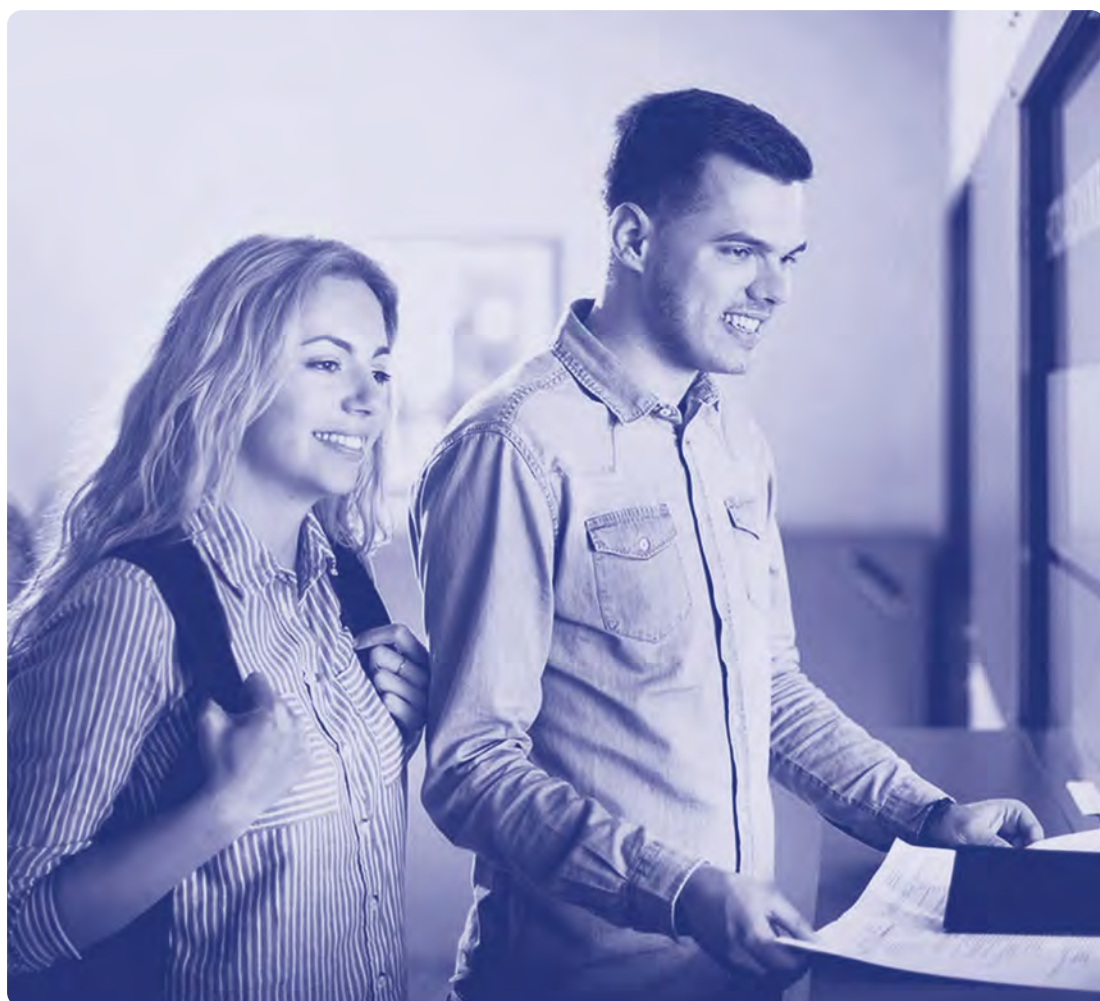


# Enrolment

A candidate can achieve a maximum of 100 points for enrolment in the corresponding study program:

- **based on general success in previous education (50 points)**
- **based on success on an entry exam and/or on aptitude test (50 points).**

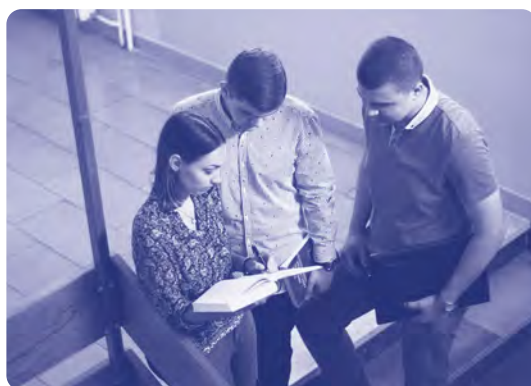
The general success in secondary school is presented rounded to two decimal points. A candidate can enroll in the study program if he or she achieves at least 15 points in the entrance exam and if he or she is within the number approved for student enrolment on the candidates' ranking list.



# Studies according to Bologna principles and lasting of studies

The University of Banja Luka applies the principles of Bologna Declaration in the teaching process in study programs in all three cycles. The total program valuation of students in acquiring a certain qualification is shown through the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). In order for the knowledge and skills gained by our students to be comparable across the European Education Area, teaching takes place through one-semester courses, and continuous knowledge checks are conducted during the semester. The Bologna system also allows students to spend one or two semesters during their studies at one of the European universities through mobility programs.

Three-year and four-year studies of the first cycle, valued at 180 ECTS points, i.e., 240 ECTS points, are conducted at the University. The study programs are divided into academic years and semesters. Thus, following the Bologna Process principles, a student can achieve 60 ECTS per year, i.e., 30 ECTS points per semester.



# Who is eligible to enroll?

## The Second Cycle of Studies



Candidates who acquired at least 180 ECTS or 240 ECTS in the first cycle of studies, and candidates who acquired 300 ECTS on appropriate integrated academic studies of the I and II cycle, are eligible to enroll study programs of the II cycle. However, Faculties of the University of Banja Luka may separately define additional conditions for enrollment to the II cycle of studies.

The following are eligible to apply to a one-year study of the II cycle, valued with 60 ECTS:

- **Candidates who have completed the corresponding four-year academic studies of the I cycle, valued with 240 ECTS.**
- **Candidates who have completed the corresponding integrated academic studies of the I and II cycle, valued with 300 ECTS.**

The candidates who have completed the corresponding three-year academic studies of the I cycle, valued with 180 ECTS, are eligible to enroll to a two-year study in the II cycle, valued with 120 ECTS.

## Documents necessary to apply and enroll

- **Birth certificate;**
- **Citizenship certificate not older than 6 months;**
- **Original or certified copy of the Diploma on completed I cycle of studies, i.e. undergraduate study;**
- **Certificate on passed exams on the I cycle of studies, i.e. undergraduate study;**
- **Teaching Plan and Program (Curricula) of the previously completed studies (if studied on a different Faculty);**
- **Proof of payment for taking the entry exam, or aptitude check.**

# Entry Exam

In the case the number of applied candidates is higher than the number of foreseen places in the Call, the selection of candidates for enrollment to II cycle is made on a competitive basis. The Faculties will determine additional detailed criteria for enrollment to the II cycle of studies in their respective Statutes.

In the case the number of applied candidates is lower than the number of foreseen places in the Call, the selection of candidates may be made solely on the basis of general success achieved on the I cycle of studies.



# Who is eligible to enroll?

## The Third Cycle of Studies



The following are eligible to enroll in the first year of the III cycle of studies:

- Candidates who have completed corresponding studies of the I and II cycle, or integrated studies, defined by the study program of the third cycle of studies, with an average mark of at least 8.00 both on the I and on the II cycle of studies, or
- Candidates who have completed corresponding studies of the I and II cycle, as defined by the study program of the III cycle of studies, with an average mark of at least 7.50 in the I and in the II cycle of studies, provided that in the moment of applying to III cycle the candidate has published scientific paper, as the first (primary) author, in scientific magazines indexed in the Web of Science Core Collection, or
- Candidates who have completed corresponding studies of the I and II cycle, or integrated studies, as defined by the study program of the III cycle of studies, with an average mark of at least 7.50 in the I and in the II cycle of studies, provided that in the moment of applying to III cycle the candidate has published at least three scientific paper, as the first (primary) author, in scientific magazines indexed in: ERIH PLUS (European Reference Index for the Humanities and Social Sciences), SCOPUS, DOAJ (Directory of Open Access Journals), CEEOL (Central and Eastern Europe Online Library), MLA (Modern Language Association) and MKC (International Committee of Slavic Studies), or
- Candidates who have an academic degree of Master of Science / Art in the corresponding field of science/art determined by the study program of the III cycle of studies, with an average mark of at least 8.00 on graduate studies, or
- Candidates who had an evaluation of their previously acquired qualification done in accordance with the University general acts dealing with recognition of acquired education qualifications.

## Documents necessary to apply and enroll

- Birth certificate;
- Citizenship certificate not older than 6 months;
- Certified copy of the Diploma on completed I and II cycle, i.e. certified copy of the Diploma of undergraduate and master studies for pre-Bologna

students, that is, an equivalence of education profile acquired according to the previously valid regulations balanced with the title acquired upon the completion of the II cycle of studies (the originals are presented 'a vista' when documentation is handed in);

- Diploma supplement for the I and II cycle of studies (certified copies), or certificate on passed exams for undergraduate and master studies, with indicated average mark;
- Teaching plan and program (Curricula) for pre-Bologna students;
- Proof of payment of administrative costs of enrollment.



# Entry Exam

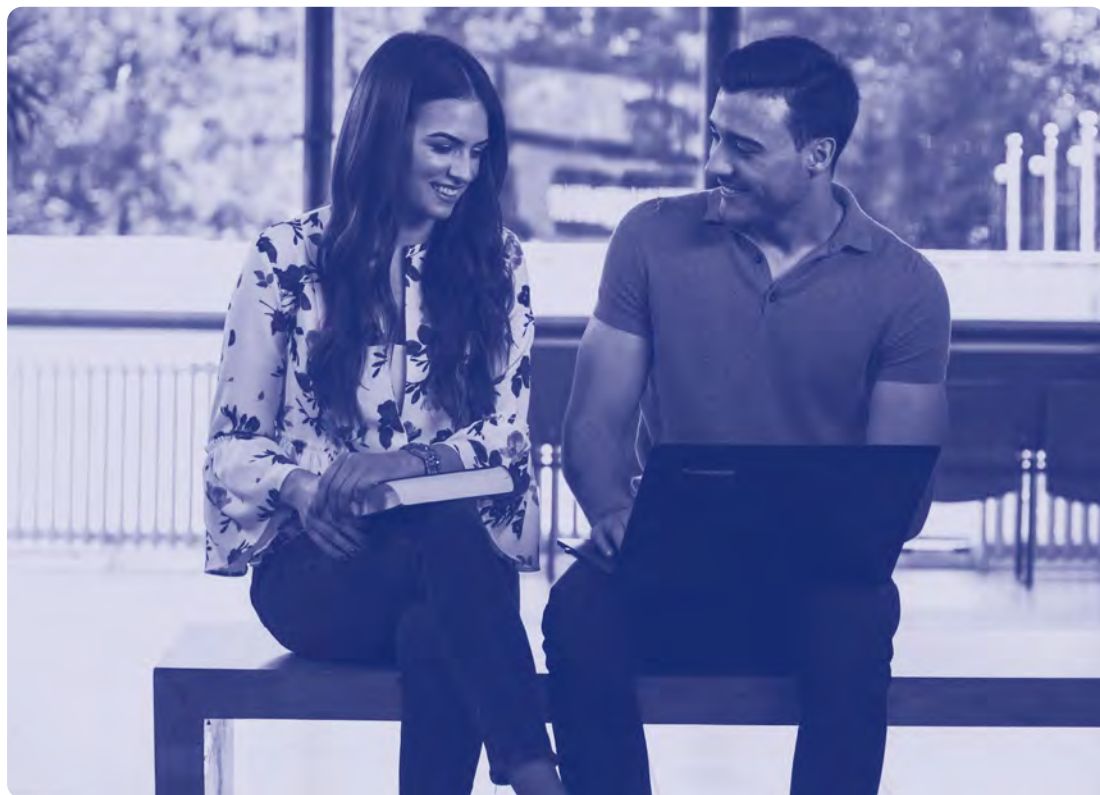
The order of applied candidates for the III cycle of studies is determined by the Teachers' Council of the Faculty where the III cycle is being implemented, based on a proposal by the Commission for admission to doctoral studies. The Commission ranks the candidates based on the following:

- **Average mark achieved on the first and second cycle of studies, or integrated studies,**
- **Length of studying,**
- **Realized scientific/art results, in line with the Law on Higher Education,**
- **As well as other conditions determined by the program of the third cycle of studies and special rules of studying in the III cycle of a particular Faculty.**

# Tuition fees

The status of a student is gained by enrolling in the relevant study program, and in accordance with the results achieved in the entrance exam.

The amount of the tuition fee depends on the student's status. According to the Rules for Studying, upon enrolment, a student can gain the status of full-time and part-time student. There are three subcategories of full-time students:

- **Students whose studies are financed from the budget,**
- **Students who self-finance their education and**
- **Foreign students.**

The amount of tuition fee for students who self-finance their study costs, part-time students and foreign students in the first, second and third cycle of studies is defined by the decision of the Steering Board.



# Foreign students

Foreign nationals who completed a four-year secondary school may enrol in the University of Banja Luka. The Diploma of completed secondary school is subject to the recognition procedure by the Ministry of Education and Culture of the Republic of Srpska.

## Necessary documents for application and enrolment

- **Copy of the Passport (photo and personal data page)**
- **Scanned Certificates for each grade of the secondary school and a graduation Diploma. Original documents and a translation by the certified court interpreter are submitted at the enrolment.**
- **Birth Certificate**
- **Proof of knowing the English language for candidates coming from countries where English is not the official school language.**
- **Proof of payment of the application fee of 100 EUR.**
- **Medical certificate**
- **Proof of payment of a tuition fee for the first semester.**

## Entry exam

In order to be admitted to the University of Banja Luka, a candidate must pass the Entry Exam, which is the same for all candidates, including foreign nationals.

## Visa and immigration

Foreign students from certain countries need a visa to enter and stay in Bosnia and Herzegovina. In that case, a student must address the Students' Service about the documentation necessary for issuing a Letter of Invitation to the Foreigner's Service office. Students who require a visa, and those who can enter Bosnia and Herzegovina without a visa, are obliged to apply for a residency permit in Bosnia and Herzegovina. # International Cooperation and Students Mobility

The University of Banja Luka offers a possibility of global education through CEEPUS and Erasmus+ programs. Starting from the second year of the first cycle of studies, students may realize the right to participate in international exchange programs. These programs enable stay at a foreign higher education institution for one or two semesters, where it is possible to listen to the lectures, pass exams, or perform technical practice.

- **Financial support: full scholarship, accommodation, food, travel, and living expenses**
- **Academic safety: all exams passed during the exchange are recognized at the mother faculty.**
- **Language advancement: studying and everyday life using a foreign language**
- **Creating one's own network: interconnecting with students from the world.**
- **Personal development: independence, adjustability, and expanding cultural horizons.**

# Students' accommodation

Students of the University of Banja Luka also have 1,250 beds available for accommodation in the four pavilions of the "Nikola Tesla" Student Centre.

## The accommodation capacities:

- Pavilion 1 (320 beds)
- Pavilion 2 (320 beds)
- Pavilion 3 (290 beds)
- Pavilion 4 (320 beds)

Pavilions 1 and 2 are placed in the so-called old campus, in Majke Jugovića 1, while pavilions 3 and 4 are located in the University Campus, Bulevar vojvode Petra Bojovića 1A. As part of the student dormitory, there are also student cafeterias, where students have three meals a day at favorable prices. In addition to accommodation and food, students have at their disposal the reading room, the Internet room, the TV room and the laundry room, as well as other contents to facilitate student life.

- **Presentations and projects relating to culture, creativity, and science**

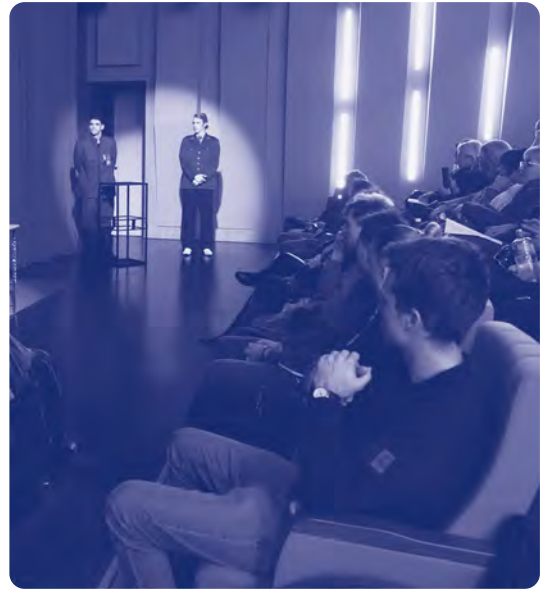
The Center has a multifunctional hall with a theatre-music stage, ideal for promoting exhibitions and various students' manifestations.

The Institute of Genetic Resources is a scientific research institute at the University.

Since 2012, after declaring the University campus a protected area, the Institute has been performing two main activities. The first activity is the maintenance of the Republic of Srpska genetic resource bank and coordination of the programs for the conservation, collection, characterization and evaluation of genetic resources and the second is the management of the protected area and maintenance of the park, botanical garden and other green areas in the University Campus on an area of 28 hectares.

Since 2014, the Institute has been undertaking teaching in collaboration with the Faculty of Agriculture and the Faculty of Natural Sciences and Mathematics within the second-cycle Conservation and Sustainable Use of Genetic Resources Combined Study Program.
